



SOUTHEASTERN DISC GOLF COURSE RULES

ALL GUESTS MUST CHECK IN AT THE FRONT DESK OF LEDFORD.

OBJECTIVE:

Complete course in fewest throws possible.

SAFETY:

Events and spectators on the Activity Field have the right-of-way.
Throw only when the landing area is clear of other players.

TEE THROWS:

Player must throw from designated tee off area.

LIE:

Shots are to be played from behind the spot where the previous shot came to rest.

THROWING ORDER:

The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole throws first.

FAIRWAY THROW:

Run-up and follow through shots are allowed, but the player must release the disc before stepping past the line. If within 30 feet of the target, then a player's throwing motion must not move past the lie until the disc is at rest.

COMPLETION OF HOLE:

The hole is completed when the disc comes to a rest in the basket or chains, not on top of the target.

UNPLAYABLE LIE:

Shots that land in a bush or tree can be spotted on the ground directly below them.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

The only designated O.B. area is Durham Rd. If an O.B. occurs, then a one shot penalty will be added. Player will take next throw 10 feet from the road. If your disc lands in a heavily wooded area, your disc will need to be thrown from that spot. Please throw the disc in the direction of the closest fairway area to prevent damage to campus trees.

COURSE COURTESY:

- Course is open only during daylight hours.
- Remain quiet while others are throwing.
- Stand behind player who is throwing until throw is complete.
- Do not alter the course (trees, bushes, etc.) in any way.
- Help new players learn the rules.
- Allow faster groups to play through when possible.
